



MILVETS SCHOLARSHIPS



The MILVETS Educational Foundation is proud to offer scholarship opportunities two times a year in support of our Central Ohio military community.

In May during the **Armed Forces Day Luncheon** three **JROTC** two **ROTC** and one **Ron Rosser** scholarships are available at \$1000.00 each. JROTC (High School Seniors) Candidates must be a US citizen and residents of Central Ohio; which includes Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Licking, Madison, Pickaway and Union Counties. ROTC (College Freshmen and Sophomores) must be US citizens. Ohio non-residency is not a disqualifier for our attending college applicants.

For ROTC Commanders...Ron Rosser received our nation's highest honor, the Medal of Honor, for his actions during the Korean War. The Ron Rosser Best of the Best Scholarship is given in his name to support exceptional ROTC recipients in their educational goals. The Ron Rosser "Best of the Best" ROTC Scholarship -one \$1,000 scholarship awarded to the outstanding freshman or sophomore ROTC candidate who best exemplifies the criteria below.

Criteria: Sponsored by Prudential Financial, the ROTC student who receives this prestigious award exemplifies the following: Unwavering and relentless commitment to duty, honor, and country through future military service, the pursuit of higher academic achievement, and to improve our country as a future leader.

The recipient will be chosen from the applicants of the ROTC submitted scholarships **and** is endorsed as the top cadet or midshipman by the ROTC Commander.

If there are no applicants that fit all requirements of this award, none will be awarded. Commanding Officer and staff endorsements are highly encouraged.

In November during the **Veterans Day Parade** five scholarships are available to **Veterans and their children/grandchildren**. Proof of service (DD-214 and Report of Separation) are required, and if applicable a written explanation of relationship to service member. It is preferred that applicants are close to attending higher education in order to receive their winnings.

Date due: Applications must be received by May 10th and November 1st.

Past recipients of a MILVETS scholarship are not eligible for additional scholarship awards.

- Each applicant must submit a completed application form, a copy of their school transcript, including their current GPA, and a 500 word essay as why they want a higher education.

- **Any applications submitted without the appropriate supporting documentation will not be considered.**
- The ROTC and Ron Rosser awards will be paid into the students account as a one-time/lump sum at the college bursar's office.
- JROTC Scholarship recipients who begin college must contact MILVETS upon school attendance in order to provide bursar/college enrollment information for award money transfer.
